WE NEED TO COVER A LOT OF SHIFTS!

- We start out with $\sim\!20$ shifts each (on-call shifts are of course counted)

DATA QUALITY SHIFTS

- ▶ DQ shift coordinator: Michael Hauschild
- ► Shift-training: One shadow shift. For new shifters (e.g. master students) it can be good to start with these shifts, where you learn to get an overview of the detector.

SCT SHIFTS

- SCT shift coordinator: Alessandra Ciocio
- SCT shifts are DCS (Data Control System) and DAQ (Date Acquisition), Monitoring (and Cooling).
- ► For each DCS and DAQ you need 1 shift training course (~1 h), and 3 training shifts (~4 h). These training shifts you can combine which means that you can cover the training in 5 days (where you spend 1 hour for courses in the first two days and 4 hours for training shifts for tree days.)
- ► For the SCT monitoring shift I believe you need one training shift
- ► Cooling shifts (Arshak and Thomas did this)

HOW TO GET STARTED:

- you need
 - ▶ Point1 computer account and e-logbook account
 - access to ATLAS Control Room (ATL-ACR) this you request in EDH
 - ▶ for SCT-training you also need access to SR1 (ATL-SR1)
- You sign up for shifts in OTP (Operation Shift Planner) but to be allowed to do that you need to have covered your shift training for SCT and for DQ-shifts you should contact M. Hauschield and arrange a shadow shift
- For the SCT training shifts you sign up in the Work Planner (select SCT Training)
